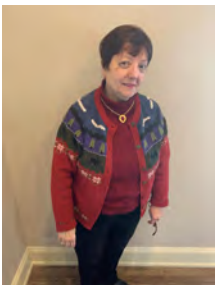

SUMMERTIME IS PIE TIME

Best & easiest pie ever from an old Amish recipe.
You can eliminate coconut & just have a custard pie topped with berries.

MIRACLE PIE (NO MESS NO MIXING BOWLS)

In a blender add

- 4 eggs
- 3/4 cup sugar
- 6 tablespoons melted butter
(When adding melted butter make sure it is a little cool.)
- 3/4 teaspoon baking powder
- pinch salt
- 2 teaspoons Vanilla extract
- 2 cups whole milk
- 1/2 cup flour (add flour last)

Blend

Lastly, add 1 cup coconut in a blender for just a few seconds

Pour into a lightly greased pie tin.

(I use butter to grease the pan)

Bake in a pre-heated 350* oven for about 45 to 50 minutes

Pie will rise and then sink, that is normal.

Let pie cool at room temperature for about 1 to 2 hours before you refrigerate pie.

This can be made without coconut for a custard pie and can also be topped with cinnamon sugar or berries and or whipped cream.
