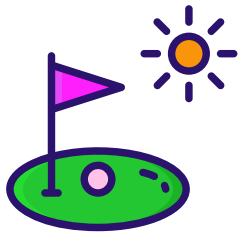

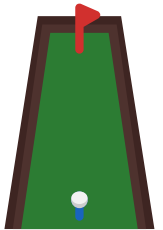


**Musical Entertainment JIM ROSETTI**

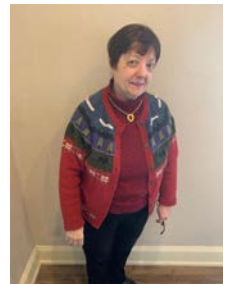

## HEINEMANN'S CHOCOLATE TOFFEE COOKIES MAKES ABOUT 3 DOZEN 3- TO 4-INCH COOKIES

11 tablespoons unsalted, very soft room-temperature butter	½ teaspoon baking soda
2 cups packed brown sugar	½ teaspoon salt
1 cup granulated sugar	1 ¾ cups unsweetened Dutch-process cocoa powder
3 eggs	½ cup coarsely chopped walnuts
1 ¾ cups unbleached flour	1 cup toffee bits (not chocolate-covered)
½ teaspoon baking powder	



Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

In large bowl, beat butter with sugars until fluffy. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition.

In another bowl, combine flour with baking powder, baking soda, salt and cocoa. Add to creamed mixture gradually. Add nuts and toffee bits and mix until combined.

Roll about 2-tablespoon portions of dough into balls, place on parchment-lined cookie sheets 2 inches apart and flatten slightly. Bake in preheated oven about 13 minutes, or until cookies are firm around the edges and cracked and mostly dry on top (inside the cracks will appear moist). Cookies will spread.

Remove from oven and let cool 3 minutes before transferring to a wire rack. Cookies should be crisp on the outside, chewy on the inside
