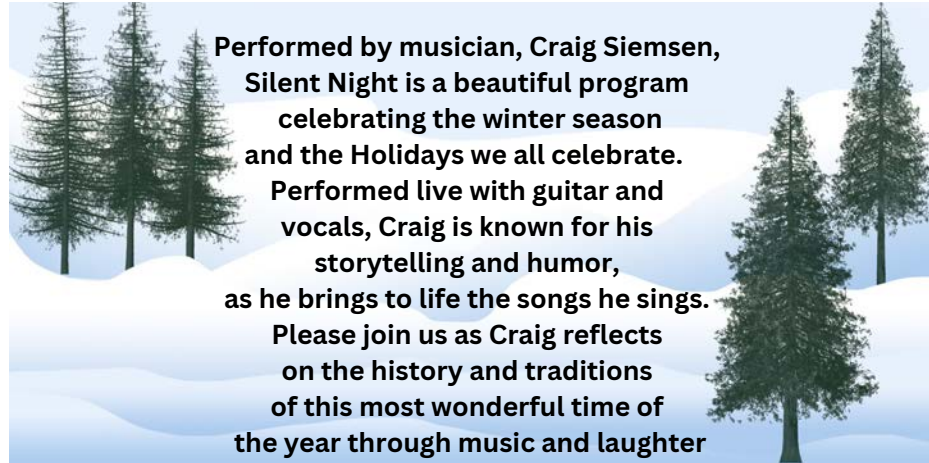
ENJOY THE SOUNDS & ENGAGING SHOWMANSHIP OF CRAIG SIEMSEN

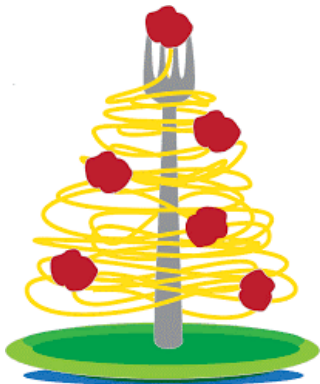

Apples can lower bad cholestrol, may prevent Alzheimers, reduce the risk of cancer, detox the liver, boost immune system, and decrease the risk of diabetes, just to name a few.

Apples are a great combination of delicious & nutritious

This is an easy fall recipe, great as a dessert with ice cream, breakfast topping for waffles, or as a side dish.

Ingredients

- ½ cup butter
- ½ cup white sugar (or brown sugar)
- 2 tablespoons ground cinnamon, or to tast
- 4 Granny Smith apples - peeled, cored, and sliced

Directions

1. Melt butter in a large skillet over medium heat. Add sugar and cinnamon; stir until sugar dissolves.
2. Add apples and cook until softened, 5 to 8 minutes.
