- ¼ cup flour
- 1½ cup turkey broth

- ½ tsp salt
- ¼ tsp ground pepper
- ½ cup cream
- 3½ cups turkey shredded, diced or chopped Instructions
- 1. In a large saucepan, melt the butter and whisk in the flour. Continue whisking until smooth.
- Whisk in the broth into the flour mixture.
   When blended whisk in the cream. Season with salt and pepper. Stir to combine. Add the turkey.
- 3. Serve over bread, potatoes, or dressing.


