February: Black History Month

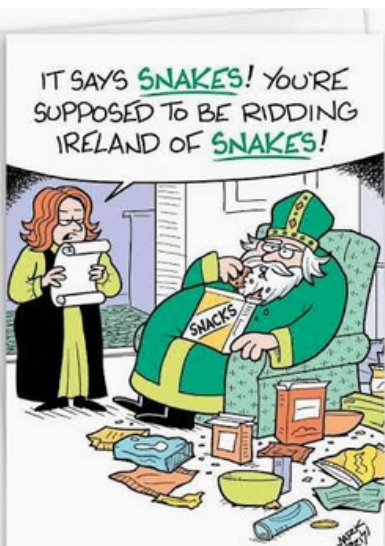
