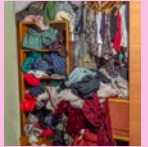

BIRDING BRAZIL: THE AMAZON AND PANTANAL

This journey provided an opportunity to tour the Amazon River at Manaus and search for birds in the surrounding area. From here, we traveled to the Pantanal, the largest wetland in the world. This rich ecosystem is home to a vast diversity of birds and other wildlife. The birdlife was a major draw, with the added bonus of seeing jaguars on more than one occasion.

The road heading south into this vast area is a 100-mile stretch of wonderful wildlife watching and adventure. The Pantanal is subject to seasonal flooding, so visits are mostly limited to the dry season. As this wetland begins to dry up, fish and other aquatic life are concentrated in the remaining pools, luring birds and other animals to this abundant food source. Searching for wildlife by boat along the riverways is a rewarding way to see the area's abundant wildlife.

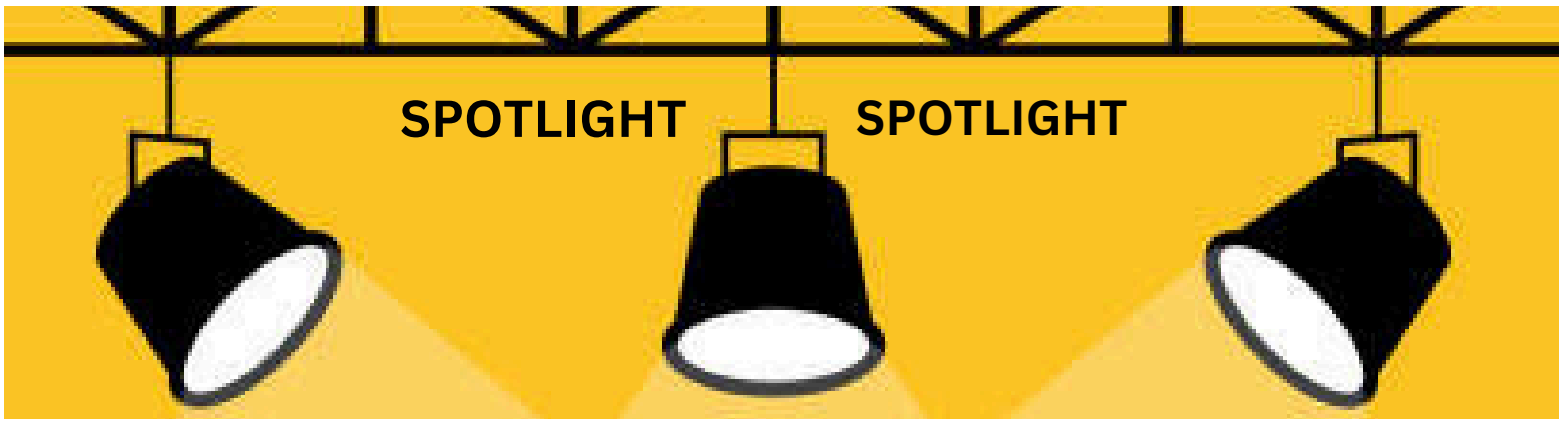

Meet and learn about our **LX Club member and Newsletter editor, Robin Estrada**, as we detail her amazing career as a dedicated professional committed to excellence in work and meaningful contributions to the community.

Robin Estrada served **26½ years with the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Department**, retiring in 2005 after a distinguished career in law enforcement. During her service, she held leadership roles, including serving as **Vice President of the Milwaukee Deputy Sheriffs' Association** for three years and as a **Trustee in the Detective Bureau for five years**. She spent approximately **13 years as a detective in the Witness Protection Unit** and was active in professional organizations, including **the National DARE Officers Association** and the **National Black Executive Law Enforcement Officers Association**.

Estrada, who founded the **WISE UP Youth Program**, which operated from 1993 until 2003, focused on helping young people make positive life choices and understand the consequences of their actions. Her work with youth initiatives led to an **invitation to the White House in 1999, 2001, and 2005**. In 1999, Estrada attended a Youth Summit, **met President Clinton, and, in 2001 and 2003, was invited to the White House for Youth Summits, where she met President George W. Bush**. In 2005, she was unable to attend. Beyond law enforcement, Robin has remained deeply involved in community education and service. She has conducted numerous workshops across Milwaukee County on crime prevention, youth development, and safety awareness. and sex trafficking awareness, speaking to youth, parents, and senior citizens. **Estrada won the DARE Officer of the Year award for 3 consecutive years, 2 awards for outstanding service as a court bailiff, 2 commendations as a Detective, and 4 awards from other law enforcement agencies for her participation in arrests, on and off duty. Estrada further received numerous awards for her service to the community as an officer and a civilian. Estrada was a Senior Investigator for the Potawatomi Gaming Commission for 15 years from 2005 to 2020.**

Her volunteer service spans decades. Estrada has been involved with the **League of Martin-Milwaukee Black Police Association for 46 years and has served on the NAACP National Convention security detail for more than 20 years**, protecting national leaders and celebrities. **Estrada is a member and newsletter editor of the LX Club Senior Organization** and has volunteered with **Adullam Outreach** for 6 years, serving in multiple roles. She has worked as the Director of Public Relations, focusing on networking, community engagement, and partnership building. Her contributions include identifying grant opportunities, assisting with grant writing, coordinating events such as coat giveaways, and helping prepare evening meals for youth and mentoring youths. She has also been a member of **the Whitefish Bay Women's Club since 2024**.

To truly capture Robin's life and accomplishments, I would have to write more than a brief article; it would take an entire book! Her story is shaped with strong values, meaningful service, and a lifelong commitment to helping others. Each chapter would reflect lessons she learned from her parents, Edna and Paul Estrada. The most important thing her parents stressed was to live by the Golden Rule: treat others as you want to be treated. Her years in law enforcement and work supporting youth and charitable causes are admirable. And whether through service, mentorship, or simple kindness, she consistently strives to lift people up. Her life reflects the enduring influence of strong family, values, quiet faith, and heartfelt commitment to make the world a better place. Wouldn't it be great if we had more Robins in this world !

Easy Pavlova

Pavlova is an elegant and impressive dessert of crisp white meringue that's fluffy and marshmallowy inside, topped with whipped cream and fruit.

PREHEAT OVEN 300 DEGREES F (150 DEGREES C)
PREP TIME 30 MINUTES
COOK TIME 1 1/2 HOURS
SERVING 8



Ingredients

- 4 large egg whites
- 1 ¼ cups white sugar
- 2 teaspoons cornstarch
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 teaspoon lemon juice
- 1 pint heavy cream
- 6 kiwi, peeled and sliced

Line a baking sheet with parchment paper, then draw a 9-inch circle on it.

Beat egg whites in a glass, metal, or ceramic bowl until stiff but not dry. Gradually add sugar, about 1 tablespoon at a time, beating well after each addition. Continue beating until the meringue is thick, white, and glossy.

Gently fold in cornstarch, vanilla extract, and lemon juice.

Spoon the mixture inside the circle drawn on the parchment paper. Working from the center, spread the mixture toward the outside edge and build the edge slightly. This should leave a slight depression in the center.

Bake in the preheated oven until the meringue is dry and sounds hollow when tapped, about 1 hour. Cool on a wire rack.

Beat heavy cream in a medium bowl until stiff peaks form; set aside. Remove the meringue from the parchment paper and place it on a flat serving plate.

Fill the center of the meringue with whipped cream and top with kiwi slices.

Top with fruit and enjoy!
