The LX Club is privileged and honored to have Barry Levinson curator and founder of the Mustard Museum as our guest speaker.



In 1992, Barry resigned from his job as an Assistant Attorney General to open this highly improbable museum, now one of Wisconsin's most popular attractions. The Mustard Museum has been featured on The Oprah Winfrey Show, the popular game shows Jeopardy!, To Tell the Truth, and You Bet Your Life with Jay Leno and has been included in countless stories on other national television and radio shows, and in major newspapers everywhere.

From a few jars of mustard that Barry purchased in 1986, the Museum collection has grown to more than 7000 mustards from all 50 United States and over 70 countries, along with hundreds of items of mustard memorabilia. Learn the history of mustard, how it is grown & produced, and its nutritional properties and medical history. The Mustard Museum is a 501(c)3 tax exempt organization, so your generous support will help us keep the mustard flowing for generations to come.

About the Speaker:

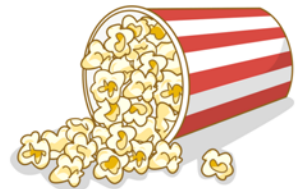

THE BEST ONIONS ARE IN SEASON NOW

Great recipe for onion lovers!

Vidalia Onion Pie

This baked sweet onion pie is a classic southern recipe. Made with Vidalia onions, crackers (Ritz or saltines), eggs, cheese, milk, and butter. Delicious savory pie!

Prep Time: 15 minutes
Cook Time: 55 minutes
Total Time: 1 hour 10 minutes
Servings: 8 servings

Ingredients

Pie Crust

2 1/2 cups crumbled crackers, Ritz or saltine crackers
1/3 cup melted butter

Pie Filling

2 tbsp butter
2 1/2 cups thinly sliced Vidalia onions
3/4 cup milk
2 eggs
1/2 tsp salt
1/4 tsp black pepper
Dash hot sauce
3/4 cup grated cheddar cheese
1/2 tsp dry parsley, optional

Instructions

- Preheat the oven to 350°F.
- Mix the melted butter into the crumbled crackers until the butter is absorbed and the crackers are wet with it. Evenly spread into a 9-inch pie pan and press on the bottom and along the sides to make a pie shell.
- Heat the 2 tbsp butter in a skillet over medium-low heat. Add the sliced onions and sauté until tender. This should take about 10 minutes.
- While the onions are sauteeing, whisk together the milk, eggs, salt, pepper, and hot sauce in a bowl until well mixed.
- Once the onions are tender, evenly spread them on the cracker pie crust. Pour the egg mixture over the onions in the pie crust. Top with grated cheese and parsley.
- Bake in a 350°F oven for 40 minutes. Let cool for 5 minutes. Slice and serve.
