## Lemon Cheese Chiffon Dessert

Remember when the popular side dish and dessert of the 50's was JELLO? Take yourself back to those good ol' retro days with this easy, delicious dessert!

1 small pkg. Jello (lemon)

1 tbsp. Sugar

3/4 c. Boiling Water

1 c. Ice Cubes

1 (3 oz.) pkg. Cream Cheese, Softened

Combine gelatin, sugar and boiling water in blender container. Cover and blend at low speed until gelatin is dissolved, about 1 minute. Add ice and stir until partially melted. Add cheese; cover and blend at high speed until smooth, about 1 minute. Pour into individual glasses or a serving bowl. Chill until set, about 30 minutes. Enjoy!
