TRY THIS DELICIOUS RECIPE!

PAVLOVA

4 cups mixed greens, chopped

6 egg whites

2 cups sugar

2 teaspoons corn starch

2 teaspoons malt vinegar

1 teaspoon vanilla

Heavy whipping cream

Beat egg whites stiff while gradually adding sugar. When adding the last bit of sugar, add corn starch and beat. Fold in vanilla and malt vinegar, and spread mixture on parchment paper on a round baking sheet (like a pizza pan). Bake at 275* for one hour - turn off oven and leave in oven for another hour. For the topping, whip heavy whipping cream, until thick and peaks form. Spread over pavlova shell, and top with lots of fruit of your choice - like strawberries and blueberries for the 4th of JULY!


