### Pavlova Recipe

Make this traditional Australian dessert recipe into an American 4th of July treat!

- 6 egg whites
- 2 cups sugar
- 2 teaspoons corn starch
- 2 teaspoons malt vinegar
- 1 teaspoon vanilla

Beat egg whites until stiff. Gradually adding sugar a little at a time. When adding the last bit of sugar add corn starch & beat fold in vinegar and vanilla. Spread mixture on parchment paper on a round cookie sheet. Bake on paper at 275\* degrees for 1 hour, turn oven off but leave in oven for another hour. Whip up some heavy whipping cream until thick and peaks form. Top Pavola with whipped cream and decorate with lots of raspberries and blueberries. Refrigerate until ready to eat..... ENJOY
