TRY THESE DELICIOUS HOLIDAY RECIPES

THANKSGIVING CORN BREAD 1 can regular corn (drained), 1 can sweet corn (drained), 1 cup sour cream, 1 stick melted butter, 1 8oz. package Jiffy Corn Muffin Mix, shredded cheese of your choice, to taste. **DIRECTIONS:** Preheat oven to 350. Mix all ingredients except the cheese. Place mixture in greased glass baking pan. Bake for 50 mins, top with cheese. Bake an additional 10 minutes, or until cheese melts.

CHRISTMAS APPLE CRISP 1, 9x13 pan filled with apples, 3/4 cup water, 1 cup sugar, 1/2 cup brown sugar, 1 cup and 1 tablespoons flour, 1.5 sticks butter, cinnamon and salt to taste. **DIRECTIONS:** Preheat oven to 350. Sprinkle apples with cinnamon and salt, water over apples. Mix sugar, brown sugar, flour, and butter together. When fully mixed, crumble like pie crust, spreading evenly over top the apples. Bake for 75 minutes, or until golden brown.

KING KOLE BLINTZ FOR HANUKAH BRUNCH 2 packages King Kole Cheese Blintzes, .25 lb. butter, 4 well-beaten eggs, 1.5 cup sour cream, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 1 teaspoon vanilla, 1 tablespoon orange juice. **DIRECTIONS:** Preheat oven to 350. Melt butter in 2 qt. casserole and place blintzes over butter in one layer. Blend remaining ingredients with eggs, pour over Blintz. Bake 45 minutes, until top starts to brown. Serve with powdered sugar, strawberries, raspberries or sour cream.

CONTRIBUTIONS

The LX Club provides the North Shore area with musical programs, special lunches, evening movies, special and educational speakers, as well as board and card games for your enjoyment. However, due to inflation over the years, our expenses now exceed our income.

We are a non-profit organization whose only source of income is the dues we receive from you as members. We do have a savings account which was started years ago to build a senior center for our community. People and businesses were generous with their contributions, but the senior center was never built. Eventually the funds were put into a savings account and we have been using these funds to subsidize expenses which exceed our income. This account is slowly being depleted by approximately \$6,000.00 per year. The Villages of Fox Point and Bayside have been

generous in awarding our club grants to pay our rent and most of the president's fee. However, we still have other expenses such as telephone and wi-fi, office supplies, liability insurance, paper products, etc. Many times, we have had to subsidize the lunches and entertainment.

We are fast approaching the 2018 tax season which is a perfect time for giving, because you will be able to deduct the amount from your taxes. Any amount you give will be greatly appreciated. NOVEMBER 14TH, 2018 | **VICTORIA AND ABDUL** 112 mins | The extraordinary true story of an unexpected friendship in the later years of Queen Victoria's (Academy Award winner Judi Dench) remarkable reign.
