

# MOVIES AT LYDELL | 1:00PM

SEPTEMBER 12<sup>TH</sup>, 2018 | **THE GREATEST SHOWMAN** 106 mins | "The Greatest Showman" is a good oil fashioned comball musical, and tells the story of how P.T. Barnum created the "Greatest Show on Earth." Played with irresistible effervescence by Hugh Jackman, it proves to be a scintillatingly flashy immersion in up-to-the minute razzmatazz.

SEPTEMBER 26<sup>TH</sup>, 2018 | **CHAPPAQUIDDICK** 106 mins | On July 18, 1969, Senator Ted Kennedy drives his car off of a bridge on Massachusetts Chappaquiddick Island. The accident resulted in the death of passenger Mary Jo Kopechne, a 28 year old campaign strategist who worked for Kennedy. The ongoing investigation into the mysterious and scandalous events forever alters his political legacy – and ultimately changes the course of presidential history.

OCTOBER 10<sup>TH</sup>, 2018 | **A QUIET PLACE** 91 mins | It is best to go into this movie knowing as little as possible about the plot. John Kraunski (The Office) directed and stars with his real wife, Emily Blunt as a married couple with kids. They have to live a near quiet existence making ANY noise can be a matter of life and death. "A Quiet Place" is a taught drama/thriller that uses virtual silence to slowly build tension. With the artful and clever concept of little to no dialogue the film keeps the audience engaged and too scared to make a sound themselves (you won't even want to munch on your popcorn)!
