He deployed to Afghanistan in 2014 in support of Operation Enduring Freedom, which is what he will be discussing.

A front page featured article in the Milwaukee Journal dated November 21st 2021 presents a disturbing picture of our soldiers returning from that war torn country. 'WE'RE LOSING SONS AND DAUGHTERS' A Wisconsin National Guard unit deployed to Afghanistan, all returned home safely. Within months, four Guardsmen took their own lives. Dr. Grohmann will be discussing

issues with the war and the returning vets..
